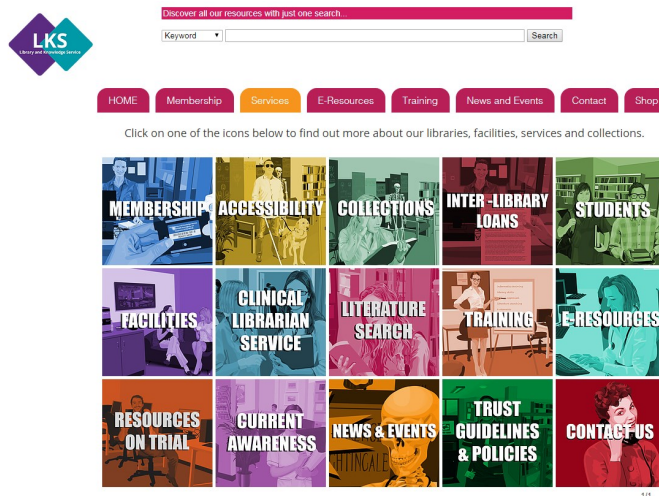

What are OpenAthens accounts?

The Athens Access Management system provides users with an individual, personal account which allows secure single sign-on to numerous web-based services purchased by your Library, including clinical databases, full text journals and E-Books.

How do I get an OpenAthens account?

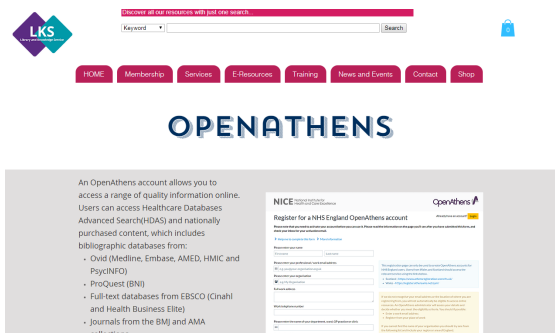

Click on the E-resources tab and select OpenAthens.



When asked for the organisation start typing **Burton** and select **University Hospitals of Derby and Burton** from the drop down menu.

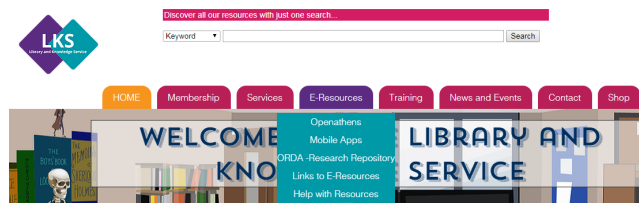
- ◆ Once the form is completed click on **Submit**.
- ◆ A confirmation screen will then appear and your username will be sent to the email address you provided. Follow the link provided in the email to set your password. Your OpenAthens account is now ready for use.
